Corrugated also has the benefit of being a cost effective way to package and display products. Then when it is all said and done, 91 percent of all corrugated is recovered for recycling! (American Forest and Paper Association, AF&PA) A single box can be recycled as many as eight times.

Even more important to you as a customer of Tilsner Carton Company is the fact that the average recycled content (from all our corrugated suppliers and using all the various paper combinations) is 73% recycled. The waste split is 65% post consumer waste and 8% pre consumer waste.

In addition, our inks are water based and can be recycled. Our adhesives are environmentally responsible. And we recycle 100% of our trim/scrap waste utilizing our baler. This adds up to 100,000 pounds per month.
